Who can appear in the Entrance Test CUET-UG (2025)?

1. Candidates having passed the qualifying examination (10+2) with required eligibility as depicted against each Program are eligible to apply.
2. **Candidates whose 10+2 examination is scheduled to be conducted during February-March 2025 are also eligible to apply for CUET-UG (2025). However, they shall be granted admission to a program only after acquiring the requisite eligibility.**

**Broad features of CUET (UG) - 2025 are as follows:**

<b>Registration</b>	Registration will be online at <a href="https://cuet.nta.nic.in">https://cuet.nta.nic.in</a>
<b>Total subjects</b>	37 (13 languages + 23 domain-specific subjects + 01 General Aptitude Test).
<b>Medium</b>	<b>13 Indian languages</b> (Assamese, Bengali, English, Gujarati, Hindi, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Punjabi, Odia, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu)
<b>Syllabus</b>	<b>Language Subjects:</b> Language to be tested through Reading Comprehension (based on different types of passages– Factual, Literary, and Narrative), Literary Aptitude and Vocabulary
	<b>Domain Subjects.</b> As per NCERT syllabus
	<b>General Aptitude Test:</b> General Knowledge, Current Affairs, General Mental Ability, Numerical Ability, Quantitative Reasoning (Simple application of basic mathematical concepts arithmetic/algebra geometry/mensuration/statistics), Logical and Analytical Reasoning
<b>Choice of Test Paper</b>	Candidates may choose upto a maximum of five (05) subjects including languages and General Aptitude Test irrespective of the subjects opted in class XII.*
<b>Marking Scheme</b>	Correct Answer: 05 marks (Five) There will be negative marking for each Incorrect answer of 01 (one) mark.
<b>Mode of the Exam</b>	<b>Computer Based Test (CBT) mode</b>
<b>Total Questions</b>	<b>50 questions for each test papers. All Question are compulsory.</b>
<b>Duration</b>	<b>Duration for each test paper would be 60 minutes</b>
<b>Shift</b>	The examination will be conducted on multiple shifts, depending on the number of Candidates and Subject choices.

\*Candidates may select the subjects based on the eligibility criteria for a programme of a desired university
