## IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING ONLINE SELECTION OF SUBJECTS OTHER THAN MAJOR FOR ALL THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN ADMITTED FOR DIFFERENT PROGRAMS FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2022

It is notified for the information of all the candidates who have been admitted vide selection **list No.1, 2 & 3** issued under No.ICS/1103-07/A-7 dated 25-6-2022, No.ICS/1233-1236/A-27/A-35 dated 07-07-2022 and NO.ICS/1303-06/A-35/N-04 dated 15-07-2022 respectively, that the stage-II of admission process in terms of program specific selection of courses other than the Major course will start in an online mode as per the mechanism detailed hereunder;

- The student will visit College website [www.islamiacollege.edu.in](http://www.islamiacollege.edu.in) and go to online Stage-II admission link. The link will open on 20<sup>th</sup> of July, 2022 4:00 PM onwards and will close on 25<sup>th</sup> of July, 2022 at 4:00 PM
- Student will login with the username and password and complete stages of selection of Minor and Multidisciplinary courses strictly as per the guidelines that will pop-up before selection of a course.
- Student will give all choices for minor and interdisciplinary courses as per the guidelines that will pop-up before the selection drop down list in order of preference.
- In their own interest the students will read the guidelines word by word to ensure that they understand the process of selection properly. The guidelines have been made explicit in terms of illustrations at every stage to ensure that no student makes any wrong choice.
- Allocation of minor and Interdisciplinary subjects will happen strictly on the basis of student choice, merit and intake capacity.
- Students are advised to check thoroughly the selection made before pressing the submit button, as subjects once locked will not be changed later on.
- Common courses for a program will be allocated by the College directly.
- Skill Enhancement Courses will be allocated after an inhouse counselling as per choice of students.

After completion of the subject allocation process every student will receive a College LMS login ID using which student can open the personal dashboard to view the subject allocation details specific to the course admitted in.
